Care & Share

Each month the Cathedral's Social Concerns Committee focuses on a ministry or community need both to increase our awareness and invite our response. Responses may range from direct involvement in a ministry to a monetary gift to a fund or organization.

January Care & Share: The Parish Assistance Fund

For some time the Cathedral of Saint James has maintained two types of discretionary funds: The Clergy Discretionary Fund, which is used primarily to offer assistance to those who come to the door from the community seeking help, and the Parish Assistance Fund, which is administered by the Social Concerns Committee (often upon the advice of the Dean) for members of Saint James who may need help. The Parish Assistance Fund works quietly and confidentially to provide funds when those with whom we worship and share fellowship have emergencies, unexpected expenses beyond the budget, or other needs.

The Parish Assistance Fund is funded primarily by the proceeds of the annual chili contest, but contributions may be made apart from that at any time. Thank you for your generosity and concern in taking care of both friend and stranger.
